All School Skate on December 18 from 12:30 - 2:00

A reminder of our all school skate on the afternoon of December 19. This skate is intended for TCS students and parents (if a few of our grandparents join like in years past we of course welcome them).

Please note: Helmets are mandatory for all students in grades JK - 4 who will be skating on the younger rink this year. These can be either bike or hockey helmets. This is critical as falls are the number one injury on an afternoon like this.

Early Dismissal on December 18


RECOGNIZING THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN NORMAL PEER CONFLICT AND BULLYING
