Parent Survey Results for TCS: very positive - thank you parents!

Thank you to all our TCS families for your participation in the OACS Parent Survey that the majority of you completed last week! We heard from 102 out of 117 of our existing TCS families - which is a very high percentage in regard to responses to a survey. Out of all the parent surveys we have done over the past six years, the participation from our parents was the very highest with this one. Thank you TCS parents!!

To quote the director of the Ontario Alliance of Christian Schools, "This was a very positive report". The board will take time this fall to review the results in more detail and a summary will go out later in September, unpacking it in a bit more detail of areas of strength and areas to keep in mind.

The one overwhelming area that 69 of our parents commented on was how much they **appreciated the Christian aspect of our school**. From the clarity and priority of the vision statement to living it out day to day and through the subjects, our landing of a Christian worldview came through loud and clear in what we do at TCS.

Next to comments on the strong Christian aspect at TCS, the next area most commented on was an appreciation for the staff and administration and how well they work as a team and how welcoming they are. A third area most commented on was the strong sense of community within the school and parents which also referred to a caring and warm environment.

Help Needed: pulling/routing cables for the New Security System

Calling all parents with computer or electrical skills...or if you are just really handy! We are in the process of installing a new buzz-in security system at TCS for the front double doors. Our plan is to have this in place for September 2018. Back in the fall the board approved \$10,000 for this project which includes the work on the front doors to prepare for the system and the hardware for the monitor/buzz-in system. The work to the doors is now complete and our next step is to run cables from the front door area through the ceiling to the computer server room to hook up to our network - which will allow us to open the door upon request.

We need a few people who have some expertise in this area to help for one evening over the next few weeks. With three or four helpers, we should be able to run all the cables in one 3-4 hour block from 6-10 pm one night. Can you help us?
