Skiing at Snow Valley—THIS FRIDAY!

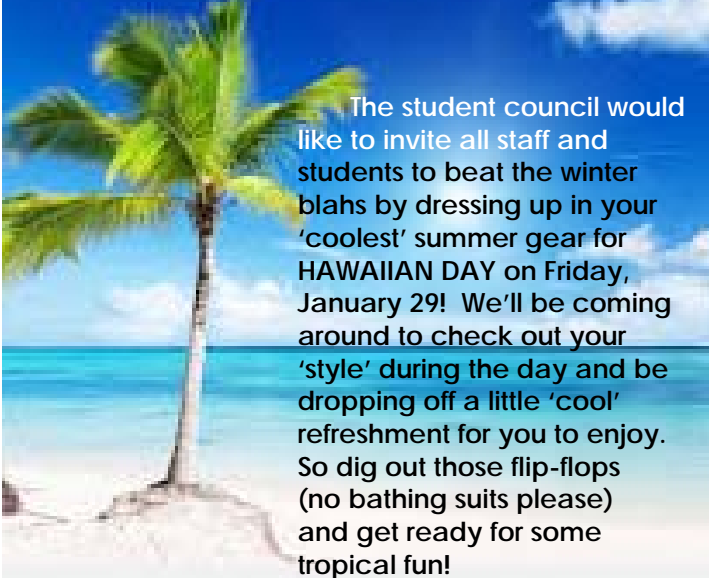
