All School Skate—Friday, Dec. 23 from 12:30-2pm

Just a reminder to all TCS parents of our annual all school family skate on December 23 at Holly Community Centre. **Students in JK—Grade 4 require hockey or bike helmets in order to participate. This is mandatory for JK—grade 4.** As well, all skates must have skate guards on or come in a sports bag to protect from blades (not a plastic bag). For safety reasons we have booked 2 rinks: One rink for students in JK-grade 3, and one rink for grades 4-8.

Here is the schedule for the last day, Dec. 23rd:

- 9:00—Christmas Chapel (All are welcome)
- 11:50—Early lunch for staff and students
- 12:15—Grades 5-8 bus leaves for skating
- 12:45—JK-Grade 4 bus leaves for skating
- 12:30-2:00—All school skate (**Hockey or bike helmets mandatory for all JK-4 students**)
- 2:00—Early dismissal from Holly Community Centre for home. Either parents pick up and check in with Mrs. Goodnough, or go home on the buses.

WE WILL BE DISMISSING BUSES AT 2:00PM FROM THE HOLLY ARENA. There are never very many students on the bus, so the routes go extra quick. PARENTS, PLEASE PLAN TO PICK UP CHILDREN 1.5-2 HOURS EARLY FROM THEIR BUS STOPS IF YOU AREN'T PICKING THEM UP AT THE ARENA.

Parents and teachers attending the skating event, please help us with reminding students to be safe re no sitting on the floor to put skates on, being careful with where we walk with our skates and helping those who are just learning to skate to be really careful re falls etc. We want a fun time and a safe time on the rinks on Friday afternoon.

Snow Day Clarification - Typo in email on Monday

On Monday morning the email sent out had a typo regarding the buses. If you had checked the Simcoe County website (www.simcoecountyschoolbus.ca) at 6:15am Monday morning you would have noticed that out of the four bus zones, Simcoe had cancelled buses in three of the zones which resulted in our bus company, Sinton, canceling all five of our buses. Going forward the email to parents on snow day mornings will simply state "Sinton has cancelled the buses therefore school is cancelled at TCS" to keep the message clear.

Guidelines for Snow Fun at TCS

A reminder of the following guidelines for enjoying the snow at school:

- Parents, please remember to send snow pants to keep clothes dry.
- No snowballs on TCS property (too many students not looking that could get hurt/too many ability levels)
- No tunneling in the snow hills (parents, we know you understand the importance of this guideline and how very critical it is to hold to this)
- Hockey sticks: Mini-sticks in grades JK—2, grades 3-4 can use bigger mini sticks and grades 5-8 can use the full size hockey sticks.
- Toboggans, shovels or crazy carpets: we as staff ask that these very fun toys **be kept at home**. When the hills get larger students quickly get hurt when they race down the hills and hit other students in their paths.

Parents, thank you so much for your support on the above guidelines. We try hard to keep the fun in the process and keep safety at the very highest level in all areas. Thus, a few reminders and guidelines go a long way to safety.



Thank you for your support with this. Student monitoring and supervision for safety is of our highest concern and we want to make sure your students are in the right areas to ensure safety. We want to avoid a student coming to an empty classroom when the intended supervision is outside. On the school front, we will remind students of this should they forget and enter the school in the mornings.
