November Parent-Teacher Conferences on November 14 or 16

There will be a new format for parent-teacher conferences this November. As stated in the year at a glance calendar in August, TCS parents will now have two options to sign up online to meet with your child's teacher:

- 2. Friday, November 16 between 9am & 12pm ⇒ There is no school on November 16 due to interviews in the morning and set-up for the Bazaar which is on Saturday, November 17. There has always been a PD day on the Friday before the Bazaar to allow TCS volunteers to set up for this major school fundraiser.

For some of the larger classes, we encourage parents to make good use of the new Friday morning option for parent-teacher conferences to take some of the pressure off of the Wednesday after school/evening which will fill up very fast. High School Information Evening (November 22)

Our intent is to run this parent high school information evening every year for the hour before the TCS Fall Membership meeting as a support for parents in this journey.


Unity Christian High School Pancake Breakfast
