From the Principal...

TCS Community BBQ this Thursday Evening!

The TCS Community BBQ is set for this Thursday:

This Friday we have our second TCS chapel with special speaker, Jenna Wickens, from Harvest Bible Chapel speaking about our school theme, "Love in ACTion." Feel free to join us for a time of praise and worship as a school community.

<u>Highlights from the September Board Meeting:</u>

1. Snow Days/Bus Cancellation Update: The board reviewed the trial year this past spring (of keeping school open when possible) and has confirmed to continue the school being open/teachers attending if buses are cancelled as we did last year going forward now. The board has given the principal the ability/freedom to cancel and close school should he feel it is unsafe to have staff and parents on the roads (this will be rare but will be an option if needed).

Note: As per years past, please keep a close eye on an email from the school office between 6-6:30am on questionable days. It will either say "Buses are cancelled but the school is open" or, "Buses are cancelled and the school is closed," like last year. A reminder that there are usually only between 45 - 60 students attending on school open/bus cancellation days so no new material will be taught as too many students are away on those days. The board made the call in this direction last year to support the 20 or so families who have no other options of where to take their children when the school was closed and to be a bit more consistent with other school systems in the Barrie area who also keep schools open when possible.

- 2. Facility Maintenance: The Board heard updates from the principal on the upgrading of the computer lab (removal of floor electrical plugs changed to wall mounts to improve student safety), updates on the new carpet in the music room and the new fire panel that was replaced as a recommendation from our fire alarm inspection in mid-August. The board was also updated on the new security buzz - in system at TCS which we are very pleased with.
- We are presently working on two more soccer nets being installed for the Junior students as well as two \Rightarrow more tether ball posts on the TCS playground to keep students active during recess and noon hour. We hope to have these installed this fall yet.
- 3. The principal and several board members hosted the New Parent Orientation last Thursday evening in the music room and were very pleased to have over 20 new parents attend this event. We welcomed 13 families and over 30 new students this year at TCS. We presently have 118 families and 228 students attending TCS as of Friday, September 14. Highlights from this meeting included promoting the PITCH program, a presentation from the Resource Thrift Shop to new families (and the need for help at the Thrift Shop), finance areas and school vision.
- Reminder that the Board hosts the TCS BBQ and invites the society to introduce themselves to Board 4. Members at the BBQ
- 5. The principal updated and reviewed the class combinations of the 4, 4/5 and 5 arrangement that allowed us to lower the student numbers in those grades from 24 and 30 (grade 4 and 5 original numbers) to 18, 16 and 20 in those classes. The board was given an update of the details involved in that process and we are pleased how this has been worked out thus far.
- The TCS Board of Directors is studying the book, "The Advantage," by Patrick Lencioni this year again 6. (started last year—a two year book study/Board professional reading) to help with good school governance. We read a chapter of this book at every board meeting, study and review it and ask, "How can we improve TCS?" in how we run the
- The reading for September included: How to \Rightarrow communicate with clarity, a variety of ways to communicate and keeping meeting summaries clear and focused.

Pastor Appreciation Day/Thanksgiving Chapel - Oct. 3




