The investigative work of the Joint Task Force over the last year has resulted in the recommendation that the two-school operations of TCS & UCHS be unified into a single one-school model. This unification would eventually cover all aspects of the school encompassing the society, membership, leadership, tuition, location, operations and facilities. After presenting at both societies Fall Membership meetings, and receiving support to further explore this concept by both School Societies by way of Motions passed, we have reached the Discernment stage of this process, where we will further develop the overall vision for a JK-12 Christian School through Community Engagement.

Our first town hall on February 29 was a well attended gathering of the community together to have collaborative conversation surrounding the long-term vision for Christian education in the Barrie and surrounding area. The feedback from the table discussions was recorded and received by the Task Force and will shape some of the content of the presentation at the second town hall on April 30th. The Task Force is encouraged by the engagement of our community as a whole and looking forward to meeting together again. ### **Logging PITCH hours**

Please be aware that it is each family's responsibility to track and log their own PITCH hours. Hours logged are pending until they have been reviewed by the PITCH Committee. To enter your hours, please follow these instructions:

- Log onto Sycamore with your family specific login (TCS School Id: 3982)
- On the left side of the School Homepage: Click "My School"
- Click "My Service Logs"
- Click "NEW" button on the right side
- Complete the form choosing the appropriate heading

- Click "Save"... entered hours are pending until approved by the PITCH committee
- Families that are required to complete ONLY 15 hours, please be sure to log the SPECIAL PITCH AUTHORIZATION of 10 hours (these are the hours granted to you so you only need to complete 15 hours in total).

Remember, <u>each family</u> is permitted to enter 2.5 hours for attending Society meetings (even if you aren't a member!). If you have questions or need further assistance, please contact <u>pitch@timothychristianschool.ca</u>
