TCS Online Learning for June

As most of you have already heard, the announcement came last week that all schools in Ontario will continue with Online learning for the month of June. The intent, from all levels of government, is that all schools will be back in class and working face to face in September. We are very excited about that this fall at TCS and can't wait to see everyone again! The message about all schools being online for the remainder of this year was very clear in the announcement last week. What was very unclear was a few of the follow up announcements about other end of the year activities. We are looking for clear direction from our local health unit/further announcements about what the last week of school could look like. As soon as we receive clarity on those items, we will email our TCS parent community. We are hoping to have this clarity by the end of this week.

Last three weeks of School at TCS

Here is an "at a glance" look at what the last few weeks of this school year will look like in June:

June 7 - June 18

- June 11 PA Day – NO SCHOOL (TCS staff have the day to write report cards)
- Online school will run as normal including speciality Friday on June 18 (June 17 for grade 8 students)
- Grade 8 drive-by celebration with family and friends at 8:00 on the evening June 18 (rain date will be the Monday)
- Parent Video Presentation by Worldview speaker Tim Barnett (all parents invited) on Wednesday, June 16th at 8:00pm on "Engaging the Minds of our Students - if we want our children to have lasting faith through their teenage years, we need to TRAIN them!"
- Thursday, June 17th, 9:30 - 10:30am - grade 4 - 8 online chapel with students led by worldview expert Tim Barnett on "Engaging the Minds of our Students/Lasting Faith"

June 21 - 24

- Like last year, this last week of school will be a special theme week for students at TCS with a strong focus on faith and worldview! Because it has been online for a while now, we would like to mix it up a bit to change the pace and also to land on a very clear faith and worldview message.
- The last week will be focusing on faith and worldview (themes will be different for kindergarten, grades 1 - 3 and 4 - 8).
- There will be no speciality Friday classes on June 25th

June 28 - 30

- The office will officially open again on Tuesday, August 17th to prepare for the new school year
- The phones will be checked, and all mail will be picked up throughout the summer
- Mr. Berg will continue to meet with potential parents and give school tours to new families throughout July and August
