# Mr. A. Wilcox and Mrs. Strikwerda Short-listed for the John Rozema Teacher Excellence Awards!

We received some exciting news this past weekend both our Mr. A. Wilcox and Mrs. Strikwerda have been short-listed (top three of all nominees across the province) for the John Rozema Award for Teacher Excellence. They have been invited to a dinner in Hamilton on June 13th where the winner will be announced.

The Rozema awards have been a special Christian school, Ontario-wide, annual award system that is supported by the Cardus Foundation over the past few years. A teacher in a school can be nominated for various categories of excellence and this year two TCS staff were nominated:

- Mr. Wilcox and Mrs. Strikwerda for the Global Issues project that grades 7 and 8 students did last spring which you may remember resulted in students creating a magazine as a final activity and raising funds for certain global issues they were learning about.
- Mrs. Strikwerda was also nominated for the Art project she did with her grade 7 class, which connected with the Barrie Food Bank and resulted in tonnes (actually!) of food going to the food bank to help others in Barrie.

These awards recognize excellence in teaching in Ontario Christian Schools and the Cardus Foundation supports the winners with significant funds to further deepen quality education in that school or for that teacher. The winner of the Excellence in Global Perspective Teaching award will receive five thousand dollars. The winner of Excellence in the Teaching of Creative and Performing Arts award will also receive five thousand dollars.

Strikwerda for their great work on those senior projects and for being short-listed for these awards!
