Keeping Germs Away!!

It has recently come to our attention that several primary students have been diagnosed with Fifth Disease. We wanted to make you aware of this because it is a viral illness that causes a distinctive red rash on the face that can then spread down to the trunk, arms, and legs. It typically starts with a low fever, headache and cold-like symptoms that pass and then the rash appears. It is contagious, but mostly before the rash appears. Children usually don't spread the infection once they have the rash. Please encourage your children to be very diligent about hand washing to help avoid spreading germs (as always). We are encouraging you to keep your eye on these symptoms and contact your doctor if you have any concerns. Thank you!
