Please note - due to a speaker booking change, the chapel that grade 6 is hosting has been moved to next week Friday, January 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am.


# Re-Registration for September 2020 Begins – next Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup>

A reminder to all our current TCS families that our re-registration timeline for September 2020 will start on **January 15**<sup>th</sup> **and close on February 1**<sup>st</sup>. Please mark your calendars that the notice to renew your registration (hold your spot for your children at TCS) for September 2020 will come next week and require a \$300 deposit (cash/cheque).

We have presently have a cap on both grade 5 and grade 6 this year, so getting registrations back to the office by the February 1<sup>st</sup> date along with a deposit cheque is critical to lock in a place for your child at TCS. Along with a deposit cheque and updated registration form committing to next year, all PITCH Forms with credit card numbers/post-dated cheques will be required to complete the re-registration process for each family. These PITCH Forms are for the next school year and will be required as part of your re-registration. If you have a JK student starting at TCS in the fall, please include that child's information on your updated registration by February 1<sup>st</sup> (along with birth certificate and immunization information).

Dear Gr. 4 to 8 Parents,

Speech Development occurs at TCS every 2 years. We would like to outline expectations for Speech Writing skills that reflect the TCS Vision and Definition of Leading Edge Learning. It is exciting to focus upon curriculum each year in the various skill development areas and enhance our abilities as teachers. As a result of this process, the Gr. 4 to 8 teachers, have put together some consistent expectations for the development of speech writing skills. Specific skills will be taught to each student during their development of speeches within their Language Arts learning. We are communicating these overall expectations so to be transparent in our vision and allow for parental support during the speech writing journey. Our parent/teacher team effort builds upon the growth mindset that our students model for us each day.

### **Overall Expectations for Speech Development**

- 1. 90% of student's speech development will occur in class. Students will be taught an introductory speech skill in class, have an opportunity to practice this skill and then be given time to apply this skill to the creation of their speech. This process will be repeated for each component of writing a speech.
- 2. There will be clearly defined academic skills and components for each student's speech, these skills will be consistent within all speech writing classrooms and represented in an assessment rubric. Specific details will be provided by your classroom teacher as they prepare your child to be a good speech writer.
- 3. There will be clearly defined presentation options depending upon the focus for each student's speech.
  - a. Competitive Strand leads to speech fest competition and thus has specific parameters that the student must meet as they prepare the deliverance of their speech
  - b. Non-Competitive Strand allows for students not interested in competing within the speech fest process to have teacher guided choices as to how they present their speech
- 4. Memorization of the speech is NOT a skill we will be assessing. Note that students will need to memorize parts of their speech, but will have q cards to assist them in their deliverance. Focus will be upon their presentation skills.
- 5. All students will present their speech to a group.
- 6. Teachers will conference with each student through-out the speech writing process and will decide with the student as to the format in which they will deliver their speech to a group.

- Teachers will have each students completed speech on hand during their deliverance of their speech to a group, if assistance is needed, prompts and words will be provided by the teacher.
- 8. There are specific skills being assessed during speech season. Here are the grade specific elements;
  - Grade 4 students will write an introduction and conclusion for a poem or scripture they are reciting.
  - Grade 5 students will be writing a personal experience speech based on a topic about themselves or a personal experience. (no research will be required for this speech).
  - Grade 6 to 8 will be writing a speech of their choice. This is their second or third time writing a speech. For this reason we want them to apply all speech writing skills from research to presentation.




