



From the Principal ...

Update on COVID at TCS

Thank you TCS parents for your patience with this newsletter as we have been spending a lot of time with public health processing the positive COVID cases at TCS. Here is an update:

- Presently we have grades SK, 2, 4 and 6 at home and online (in isolation) as well as their unvaccinated siblings. The school remains open for in-person classes for all other students.
- Students return to TCS for in-person learning again as usual:
 - SK returns to TCS this Friday, December 10
 - o Grade two returns on Tuesday, December 14
 - o Grade four returns on Monday, December 13
 - Grade six returns on Friday, December 10
- We have been informed of seven positive COVID cases at TCS from public health at this time (several in the same classes who are now online). These are not necessarily cases that were passed on at TCS but are students in our school who tested positive.
- Simcoe health has informed us they are now considering us an 'outbreak' due to two in the same cohort who may have contracted it from each other
- Simcoe Muskoka District Health Unit has been very good to work with through this time and have confirmed that we are doing everything we should be doing
- The TCS homeroom teachers are running classes for the in-person students and are also sending work home for Math, Language Arts, Bible and Science/or Socials for the students who are doing at home learning (either in isolation or who are not well or who are being cautious and choosing to stay home)
- Staff will run this hybrid (in-class and at home) system up to the end of next week to support learning
- We strongly encourage families who are at home to work through the assignments that are being sent home to keep the learning happening on the home front and to use the support systems offered
- The Resource Support has been assigned as follows:

 - Please connect with these teachers if you need one on one support for assignments at home as they are running Google meets all day to support students in these grades who are at home
- All extra-curricular activities have been suspended due to the COVID outbreak at TCS. Unfortunately, this includes the skating that was planned for next Friday.

Thank you TCS families for your support as we do our best to keep learning at a very high level for the next few weeks.

TCS Directive: Online COVID screening tool will start next Wednesday, December 15 at TCS
The province is now mandating that parents MUST report the results of each student's daily
COVID screen to their child's school each day starting on January 3rd, for the weeks following
Christmas holidays.



TCS will start this mandatory reporting of screening results to the school next week so we will be prepared after the break. We have put the provincial screening tool in our Sycamore School database so that we can easily track and record each students screening results. *Parents, please complete the screening tool for each student each day* before leaving for school to ensure only students that pass the screen are attending school.

The tool can be found on our Sycamore School homepage. Here are the instructions to access it:

- Log into Sycamore School (the same as booking your parent-teacher conferences last month) with your family specific login (please contact the office asap for assistance with this if needed)
- On the right-hand side of the homepage, you will see "Complete the COVID-19 screening tool"
- Click on "Complete the COVID-19 screening tool"
- You will see a screen with your child's (children's) name(s)
- Please click on a name and complete the tool for that student for that day, hit submit when completed
- Proceed to complete the screening tool for each of your children, hitting "submit" at the end of each

When you hit "submit" you are sharing the results with the TCS office which will enable us to confirm your child's suitability to attend school that day and be able to quickly do classroom counts and tracking.

Year-end donation opportunity

As we draw closer to the end of 2021, some of you may be interested in making a year-end gift to Timothy Christian School. One way you can do this is through appreciated securities through the Christian School Foundation. If you have unregistered publicly traded securities that have gained in value over the time you have owned them, using these gifts to our school can be a great idea! HOW does this work? If you bought shares for \$1,000 and they are now valued at \$5,000 – they are subject to Capital Gains tax if you convert them to cash first. Instead, if you transfer them directly to a charity, you will give a gift that cost you \$1,000, but you will get a donation receipt for a \$5,000 gift (for many, reducing their taxes by approx. \$2,000)! Since the charity doesn't pay capital gains taxes when they convert them to cash, it gets the full \$5,000 in funds to support its important work! Calling for Christmas decorations


