PITCH OPPORTUNITIES: EQUIP Conference

Planning for the Equip Conference is well underway, and we have several ways you can help (and earn your PITCH hours). Many of these roles can be done in shifts, or if you really want to crush those PITCH hours, sign up for the entire day! Note: if you would like to sign up for multiple volunteer positions, then please fill out ONE form for each position. (Example: to sign up for setup and childcare, you will need to fill out two forms).

- -Setup Crew: Setup will take place on Friday morning (March 31st). This will mainly include tables and chairs and Signage.
- -Youth Conference: The Youth Conference will take place on the evening of March 31st. We will need some volunteers to help supervise this event. This role will also include collecting tickets, and serving food or snacks.
- -Welcome/ Registration Team: We are looking for some friendly individuals for this team. This role includes greeting everyone at the door, taking care of registration, directing people through the halls, and also helping out wherever we need an extra hand.
- -Childcare:During the conference, we are providing childcare for all of those who are attending. We are going to need lots of extra hands to love on these children. We are also looking for some volunteers to take on roles such as Snack and Craft Organizers and Team Leaders.
- **-Food Service:** We need a team of volunteers who are able to prep, serve and clean up during the lunch break. We will also need some people who are able to manage the bake sale.
- **-Baking:** If you are not able to volunteer on the day of the event, we are also in need of some baked goods donations. These baked goods will need to be NUT-FREE and individually wrapped.
- -Parking Crew: This role involves directing traffic in the parking lot, and also keeping the sidewalks clean.
- -Tech Team- Sound/Media: We are in need of some tech savvy individuals, mainly we are looking for those with AV experience, and those who are able to run programs such as PowerPoint, Prezi or Keynote. If you do not have technical experience, but are still good with computers, our Tech Team may be able to train you on the basics. The Tech Team also needs to be available to set up equipment the day before and takedown afterwards.
- -Takedown Crew: The takedown crew will be responsible for cleaning up tables, chairs and sweeping the floor.

- Number of tubing tickets
- Name of person picking up the tickets

All tickets must be picked up on the date of your reservation *no later than 5:15pm with exact change* (CASH ONLY). You will need to pick up your tickets from Kathryn in the chalet at the top of the stairs (look for the TCS sign).


Bus reminder
